Why did Jesus have to die?

“ God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life.” John 3:16.

1. Jesus died because we need a Savior. ***“ For all have sinned and come short of the glory of God.”(Romans 3:23)***

2. Jesus is the only one who could die because He is the only one without sin. ***“ For He hath made Him to be sin for us, who knew no sin, that we might be made the righteousness of God in Him.”(2 Cor. 5:21).***

“ Neither is there salvation in any other; for there is none other name given among men, whereby we must be saved” (Acts 4:12).

3. It took the sinless blood of Jesus to free us from our sins. ***“Unto Him that loved us and washed us from our sins in His own Blood.” (Rev.1:5)***

“ In whom we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins” Eph. 1:7.

“ who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom of His dear Son; in whom we have redemption through His blood even the forgiveness of sin” (Col 1:13-14).

“ For thou was slain and has redeemed us to God by thy blood out of every kindred, and tongue, and people, and nation” (Rev 5:9).

There are so many scriptures on the power of the Blood of Jesus and the necessity of Jesus dying on the cross for us all. I have listed just a few but remember it is only those who are perishing that think it is foolish, don't be one of them. ***“ For the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God” (1 Cor. 1:18).***

Let me give you one last scripture about how to be saved (having eternal life, made ready for heaven).

“ Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things, such as silver and gold, but with the precious Blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot.”

Remember Jesus rose again and ***“... ever lives to make intercession.” (Hebrews 7:25)***

Jesus has paid in full for your salvation, all you have to do is receive Him into your heart and make Him your Lord and Savior and you will be His child forever.


Pray this following prayer and it will help you find salvation through Jesus Christ.
